Everyone who learns, plays and works at the Wilhelm-Busch-Schule should feel comfortable. It is therefore important that we respect each other, treat each other politely and fairly and adhere to the agreed rules.

1. Interaction with each other

We feel comfortable when we are addressed by others in a friendly, polite and calm manner.

That's why I endeavour not to insult or laugh at anyone.

I resolve disputes and problems peacefully through dialogue. If I am unable to settle a dispute, I seek help from the mediators or teachers.

I respect the property of others and treat it with care.

2. In the school building

I walk slowly and quietly in the corridors and on the stairs to avoid noise and accidents. The school building is not a climbing park, there is no climbing or sliding down the banisters.

I hang my jacket on the coat hook outside my classroom.

Children do not wear headgear or gloves in the classroom. I hang them up outside the classroom or stow them in my school bag.

In my classroom, I observe the class rules that we have agreed together with our teacher.

It is not permitted to stand on the fire escape.

3. In the schoolyard

I arrive at school on time at the start of lessons and walk quickly to class.

If I come to school by bike or scooter, I get off at the school gate and push so as not to hurt the other children.

I leave my bike or scooter locked in the appropriate car park. The school accepts no responsibility for damaged or stolen bikes or scooters.

I use the rubbish bins in the school playground to keep it clean.

4. During the breaks

During the breaks, I go to the playground and can play, climb, run and romp around.

I stay in the playground for the entire break. I can always find supervisors here who I can go to for help if I have a problem.

I don't throw stones, sticks, sand, snowballs or other objects so that I don't hurt anyone during the break.

I behave fairly and considerately on the play equipment and take turns with the other children.

I only sit in the nest swing with one other child at most, while one child is allowed to push us.

I use a softball for ball games to avoid injuries and accidents.

Fights, even so-called fun fights, are not allowed at school.

If I take a toy from the break box into the break or borrow one from the break lender, I return it at the end of the break.

As soon as I hear the break bell, I go quickly to class.

5. During the rain break

During the rain break, I stay in my classroom and keep myself quiet.

6. In the toilet facilities

I only go to the toilet when I really "have to". I leave the toilet as clean as I would like to find it myself.

I only stay in the toilets for as long as necessary.

After I have washed my hands properly, I remember to switch off the water again. I only use as much paper as I need to dry my hands and throw it in the bin.

7. End of the school day

As soon as the lesson is over, I get ready to leave and go home, to after-school care or childcare.

8. Parents at school

My parents only accompany me as far as the school gate. From here, I manage the rest of the way on my own.

My parents only enter the school grounds during school hours in exceptional cases (for example: agreed appointments with teachers or the school management, emergencies, voluntary work).

If I have forgotten something at home, my parents will not bring it to school afterwards.

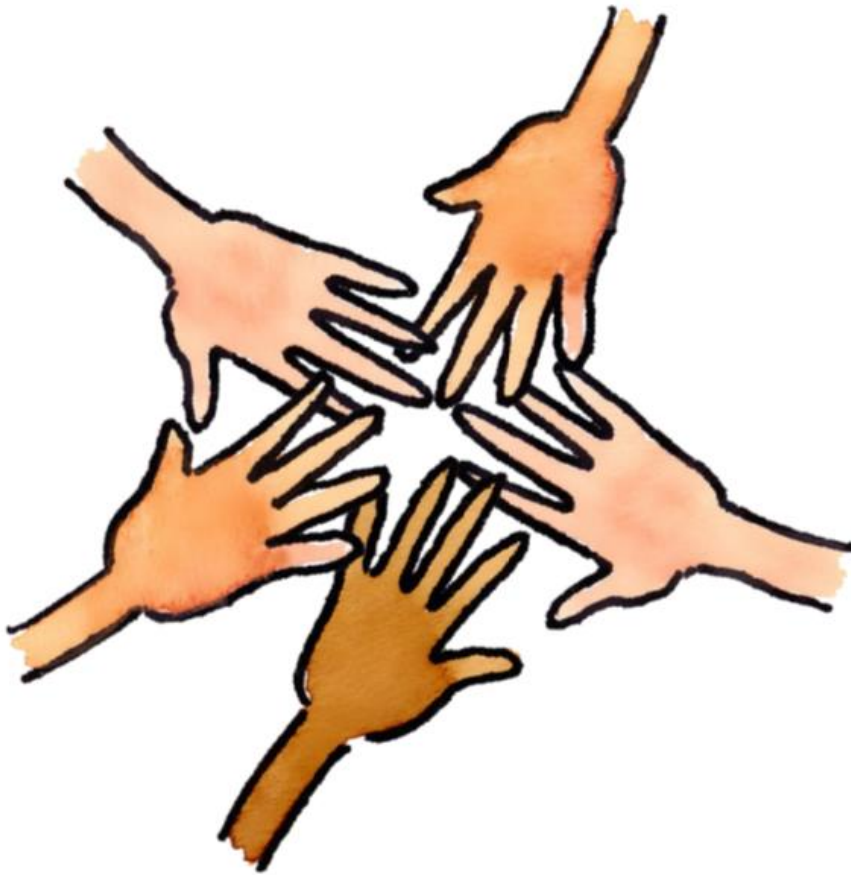
9. General information
